1. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply a copy of this writ petition to Mr. V.D. Gathala, AGC appearing for the respondents No.1 to 3 and Mr. Nalin G. Narayan for respondent No.4 and Mr. Archit Bohra, AGC for respondent No.5.
2. Office is directed to reflect the names of learned counsel Mr. V.D. Gathala, AGC, Mr. Nalin G. Narayan and Mr. Archit Bohra, AGC as counsel for respondents.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that petitioner was selected as on the basis of examination conducted on 17.08.2025. He further submitted that after being qualified in written examination he was called for verification of documents by appointing authority where his disability certificate was questioned and thereafter he was asked to go in Hospital of Satellite and JLN Ajmer and obtain a medical certificate and during his medical examination the petitioner was orally informed that his disability is only zero percent. The respondents discarded the candidature of petitioner vide letter dated 30.12.2025.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner also relying upon the **Order dated 17.09.2025 in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.13222/2025 (Bhulesh Meena vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors.)** passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court and submitted that petitioner be permitted for re-examination.

5. Having considered the submissions of learned counsel for parties and on perusal of material placed on record, without going into the veracity of the claim made by present petitioner and in order to balance the equity, and in the interest of justice, this Court deems it appropriate to direct All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Jodhpur to examine impairment/physical disability of petitioner (with specific reference of Right Leg) from a competent Medical Board.

6. In view of aforesaid, the petitioner is directed to appear before the Director of All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Jodhpur on 06.02.2026 for medical examination by Board to assess impairment/physical disability. A report be prepared and

same be sent directly to respondents and also a copy to this Court.
