HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE ANUROOP SINGHI**Order****25/02/2026**

The present matter pertains to a transfer application filed by the petitioner seeking transfer of suit No.32/2022 and temporary injunction application No.26/2022, which is pending in the Court of Assistant Collector, Sikar.

Without traveling into the merits of the said application and so also the order dated 08.01.2026 passed by learned Board of Revenue, vide which the said transfer application has been dismissed, learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr. Ajay Gupta, at the very outset and upon instructions, has expressed his utmost faith in the proceedings being carried out in the said civil suit and thus, he is not willing to press the present writ petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for liberty to file an appropriate application before the learned Court of Assistant Collector, Sikar, for seeking disposal of the said suit in accordance with law and without being influenced by filing of the transfer application by the petitioner.

Considering the above submissions, the liberty as prayed for is granted and consequently, the writ petition stands disposed of.
