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**HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE ASHOK KUMAR JAIN**

**Order**

**27/02/2026**

1. Instant writ petition is preferred by petitioners with following prayer:

The respondents may kindly be directed to grant notional benefit to the petitioners like similarly situation incumbent namely Mahendra Kumar Meena from date of his appointment till her actual joining on the same post pursuant to order dated 22.11.2018 issued by the respondent No.3 with all consequential service benefits.
2. Mr. Prateek Saxena on behalf of Mr. Kapil Prakash Mathur, AAG accepts notice on behalf of respondents
3. Office is directed to reflect name of Mr. Kapil Prakash Mathur, AAG as counsel for respondents.
4. Learned counsel for petitioners while referring and relying upon **judgment dated 08.08.2025 in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.11564/2025 titled as Prem Chand and Ors. Vs. State of Rajasthan and Ors.** submits that the controversy and the issue raised herein is already settled by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Hon'ble Court on the basis of ratio laid down in case of **Pawan Meena Vs. State of Rajasthan and Ors. (SB CWP No.1665/2024 order dated 02.02.2024)**. He further submitted that instant writ petition be disposed of in accordance with aforesaid order.
5. Having considered the submissions of learned counsel for parties and also material placed on record, the writ petition may be disposed in light of **Prem Chand and Ors. Vs. State of Rajasthan and Ors. (supra) Pawan Meena Vs. State of Rajasthan and Ors. (supra).**

6. In view of aforesaid, the writ petition is disposed of in terms of ratio laid down in case of **Prem Chand and Ors. Vs. State of Rajasthan and Ors. (supra) Pawan Meena Vs. State of Rajasthan and Ors. (supra)**, if applicable upon facts of the case. The respondents are at liberty to verify veracity of the facts before extending the same benefits to the petitioners.
7. Needless to say that if ratio is applicable upon facts of the case as claimed by the petitioners, then same benefits be extended to the petitioners.
8. With the aforesaid directions, the present writ petition with pending application, if any, stands disposed of.
