After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner-college made a limited prayer that the petitioner may be permitted to make a representation as regards the refund of affiliation fees which the respondents have charged twice from the petitioner-college.

In view of the limited prayer made by the counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner is allowed to make a representation to the respondents for redressal of its grievances as regards the



refund of the affiliation fees which alleged to have been charged from the petitioner-college twice.

In case the respondent-authorities receive any representation from the petitioner-college as regards the refund of the affiliation fees which has been charged twice, they shall consider and decide the same by passing a reasoned and speaking order, as early as possible preferably within a period of one month.

Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed of.

In view of the order passed in the main petition, the stay application and pending application/s, if any, also stand disposed of.
