1. By way of filing the instant criminal misc. petition, a prayer has been made for issuing directions to the Investigating Officer for conducting fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.248/2019 registered with Police Station Dabi, District Bundi for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 418, 406, 467, 468 and 471 IPC.
2. At the outset, learned Public Prosecutor apprised this Court that after investigation, the Police has submitted Final Report (Negative) in the impugned FIR on 07.06.2022 before the Court of Judicial Magistrate, Talera District Bundi by finding the case of civil nature and the same was also accepted on 07.02.2024 by the concerned court. Hence, under these circumstances, the instant criminal misc. petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Considering the above, this criminal misc. petition stands dismissed as having become infructuous. Stay application as well as all pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.

4. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail the remedies available to him under the law assailing the validity of the order dated 07.06.2022 before the competent forum of law.

5. The factual report dated 16.04.2026 furnished by SHO, Police Station Dabi District Bundi is ordered to be retained on the record.
