- 1. This anticipatory bail application has been filed under Section 482 BNSS in connection with FIR No.0119/2025 registered at Police Station Manoharpur, District Jaipur Rural, for the offence(s) under Sections 303(2), 329(3), 351(2) and 352 of BNS.
- 2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case. He also submits that petitioners have joined the investigation, as per directions of the Court. He further submits that recovery have been effected at the instance of co-accused Ravi Kumar who has been enlarged on bail by the Trial Court itself vide order dated 17.11.2025. He submits that petitioners have no criminal

antecedents and are not required for further investigation, therefore, prays that the petitioners may be granted the benefit of anticipatory bail under Section 482 BNSS.

3. Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor vehemently opposes the submissions made by accused-petitioners hereinabove.

4. Taking into consideration the overall facts and circumstances of the case and considering the fact that petitioners have joined the investigation; recovery have been effected at the instance of co-accused Ravi Kumar who has been enlarged on bail by the Trial Court itself vide order dated 17.11.2025 and petitioners have no criminal antecedents. Hence, this Court without expressing any opinion on the merits/demerits of the case, deems just and proper to extend the benefit of anticipatory bail to the accused-petitioners.

5. Accordingly, this anticipatory bail application under Section 482 BNSS is allowed and it is ordered that in the event of arrest of **Nirmala Devi W/o Rameshwar Prasad & Sugna Devi W/o Bhagwan Sahay**, they shall be released on bail on furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- each to the satisfaction of S.H.O./I.O./Arresting Officer of the concerned Police Station in FIR No.0119/2025 on the following conditions:-

- (i) that the petitioners shall make themselves available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioners shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the court or any police officer, and;

(iii) that the petitioners shall not leave India without previous permission of the court.
