**Order**

1. The present civil first appeal has been filed by the appellants against the judgment and decree dated 07.11.2025 passed by learned Additional District Judge No.1, Khetri District Jhunjhunu (Raj.) (hereinafter referred to as the learned 'trial Court') in Civil

Suit No. 17/2020, whereby, the suit filed on behalf of the respondents for claiming compensation for the death of one Manish due to electrocution has been decreed and an award of Rs.10,34,520/- along with interest @ 7.5% is awarded in favour of respondents.

2. Heard on Stay Application No. 922/2026.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the appellants submits that the effect and operation of the judgment and decree dated 07.11.2025 passed by learned trial Court be stayed till the pendency of this appeal.

4. The matter requires consideration.

5. Issue notice to the respondents by both modes i.e. by ordinary course as well as by registered post, returnable after six weeks. Requisites be filed within a period of one week.

6. The appellants are directed to deposit 50% of the amount of award along with the interest granted in favour of the respondents vide impugned judgment and decree dated 07.11.2025 in Civil Suit No. 17/2020, with learned Additional District Judge No.1, Khetri District Jhunjhunu within a period of 30 days from today.

7. On depositing the said amount by the appellants, the same shall be disbursed amongst the respondents in terms of the award on an undertaking by the respondents that in case, appeal of appellants succeeds, the respondents shall repay the amount, so received, along with interest @ 6% per annum.

8. If the aforesaid amount is deposited by the appellants within the stipulated period, then the effect and operation of the impugned judgment and decree dated 07.11.2025 shall remain stayed, till further orders of this Court.



9. List the matter after six weeks.
10. In the meanwhile, record of the Court below be summoned.
