1. Learned counsel for the accused-applicants submits that for the last 4-5 months, the trial is lingering on and eye-witnesses are not appearing for recording of their statements before learned trial Court. Learned counsel also submits that it seems that eye-witnesses are not appearing deliberately just to avoid the hearing of bail application because first bail application was dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file a fresh after recording of the statements of eye-witnesses, therefore, learned trial Court be directed to record the evidence of eye-witnesses on priority basis.
2. On 24.04.2025, while dismissing the first bail application No. 1797/2025, this Court granted permission to file a fresh after recording of statements of eye-witnesses, however, only statement of one eye-witness has been recorded during trial and certified copies of order-sheet makes it clear that other eye-witnesses are not going to the learned trial Court for recording of their statements.

3. In these circumstances, learned trial Court is directed to examine eye-witnesses namely; Vijay, Nisha and Govind on priority basis preferably within one month from the next date i.e. 13.02.2026 fixed before the learned trial Court.
4. List the matter after six weeks.
