1. The present bail application has been filed under Section 482 BNSS in connection with FIR No. 416/2025 registered at Police Station Naugaon District Alwar for the offence(s) under Sections 5, 6, 8, 9 of the Rajasthan Bovine Animal (Prohibition of Slaughter and Regulation of Temporary Migration or Export) Act, 1995.
2. Learned counsel for the accused-applicant submits that the applicant is sole bread earner of the family, aged about 37 years. It is submitted that there are no criminal antecedents registered against the applicant. It is further submitted that applicant has falsely been implicated and has no role to play in the instant matter. Relying upon the provisions enshrined under Section 8 of the Rajasthan Bovine Animal (Prohibition of Slaughter and Regulation of Temporary Migration or Export) Act, 1995, learned counsel submits that whoever contravenes or attempts to

contravene or abets the contravention of the provisions enshrined under Section 3 (Prohibition of slaughter of bovine animal) of the Act shall, on conviction, be punished with a rigorous imprisonment for a term which shall not be less than one year but may extend to ten years. Learned counsel also submits that the applicant is ready to abide by the conditions, if any, imposed by this Court while enlarging the applicant on bail.

3. *Per contra*, learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the instant bail application.

4. Having heard the arguments advanced by the learned counsel for the parties and considering the fact that the applicant is sole bread earner of the family, aged about 37 years; that there are no criminal antecedents registered against the applicant; and looking to the overall facts and circumstances of the case and material on record but without commenting on merits/demerits of the case, this court is inclined to allow the bail application of the accused-applicant subject to the condition that the accused-applicant joins investigation within a period of ten days.

5. Accordingly, the anticipatory bail application is allowed. The S.H.O/I.O/Arresting Officer, Police Station Naugaon District Alwar in F.I.R. No. 416/2025 is directed that in the event of arrest of the accused-applicant **Mehboob S/o Shri Asloop**, he shall be released on bail, provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the S.H.O/I.O/Arresting Officer of the concerned Police Station on the following conditions:-

- (i) that the applicant shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;

(ii) that the applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or any police officer, and

(iii) that the applicant shall not leave India without previous permission of the court.
