Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that an application under Section 37 of the Rajasthan Police Act, 2007 was submitted by Investigation Officer before concerned trial Magistrate for issuing standing warrant of arrest against the petitioners. Counsel submits that in the said application, material facts were concealed and true facts were not disclosed by the Investigation Officer before the trial Court. Counsel contends that earlier on 01.06.2025, petitioner No.1 appeared before Investigating Officer and on that day, notice under Section 133 of

Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 was served upon him. Counsel has placed certain documents on record showing that on 01.06.2025, petitioner No.1 visited police station, however, perusal of the application would reveal that such facts were not disclosed.

Learned State counsel is directed to file reply to the petition within a period of two weeks from today.

List this case on 25.08.2026.

In the meantime, petitioners shall not be arrested in connection with FIR No.157/2024 registered at Police Station Kolari, District Dholpur.
