Arguments have been heard in part.

Learned counsel for the respondents prays for time to file additional affidavit in order to controvert the contents of Para-E of the writ petition, where it has been pleaded by the petitioner that dozens of other similarly situated persons, who were having domicile certificate from State of Rajasthan have been selected and appointed against the vacancies of other States.

In the additional affidavit the respondents are required to clarify as to whether such persons are still continuing in service or not? In case, stand of the respondents is that they were wrongly selected and appointed then what will be the future course of action, which the respondents intend to adopt in this matter.

Let the affidavit be filed within a period of 7 days with advance copy to learned counsel for the petitioners.

Let these matters be listed on 18th February, 2026.

In case, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to file any counter to the additional affidavit, he may also do so by the next date.

It is made clear that no further adjournment shall be granted in this matter.
