1. Counsel for the petitioners submits that grievance of petitioners is common and issue involved in all three writ petitions is identical, hence, on his request, all three writ petitions have been tagged and heard together.
2. It has been submitted that petitioners being a "AA" Class Government Contractors, have completed the repairing/

construction work of road, which has been verified in the Third Party Quality Assurance as well as completion certificates have been issued in favour of petitioners by the concerned Executive Engineer, PWD, yet vide letters/orders impugned dated 13.01.2025, 14.01.2025 and 24.01.2025, petitioners have been asked to do the work again.

3. It has been pointed out that issuance of letters/ orders dated 13.01.2025, 14.01.2025 and 24.01.2025, in view of above facts and that too after a delay of more than one and half years from the date of issuance of completion certificate, is an arbitrary, perverse and unwarranted action of respondents, as much as same have been issued in breach of the principles of natural justice.

4. Heard.

5. Issue notice of the writ petitions as also of stay applications to the respondents.

6. In the meanwhile, operation of the impugned letters/ orders dated 13.01.2025, 14.01.2025 and 24.01.2025, in respect of each petitioner shall remain stayed.
