1. Without pressing the writ petition on merits, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be granted liberty to approach the learned Trial Court with a prayer that he is willing to deposit a certain amount before the learned Trial Court. He further submits that, if the learned Trial Court considers it appropriate, the order directing his civil imprisonment may be deferred for a specified period to enable him to take appropriate steps by way of filing a first appeal or, in the alternative, to arrange and deposit the requisite amount for payment.
2. Considering the same, the present writ petition is disposed of with aforesaid liberty.
3. If any such application is filed before the learned Trial Court, it is expected from the learned Trial Court to decide it in accordance with law.

4. With the above observations, the present writ petition stands disposed of.

5. All pending application(s) stand disposed of.
