1. The learned counsel for the petitioner seeks a short adjournment.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent opposed the adjournment on the ground that the project of the Rajasthan Housing Board is being stalled because of the pendency of the present PIL. Learned counsel for the respondent further submits that even the prayer made by the petitioner in the writ petition does not survive any more because as per the distance norms of the highway in question, the present project does not fall in the prohibited zone, in fact, the national highway itself has been shifted away from the project due to its design.

3. In the interest of justice, the prayer for an adjournment is accepted.
4. List the matter on 18.05.2026.
5. However, in the meanwhile, it is made clear that the Rajasthan Housing Board is permitted to continue with the public project in question.
