These writ petitions have been adjudicated as a continuous *mandamus* and various issues pertaining to Jaipur City, namely;
(1) cleanliness; (2) encroachments; (3) transportation and traffic;

(4) parking; and (5) stray animals, have been repeatedly brought to the consideration of this Court and dealt with at length.

The various orders pertaining to the aforementioned issues have also been passed by the Hon'ble Apex Court; and a duly constituted Committee was formed with the obligation of ensuring that all necessary steps are taken in respect of the issues in question.

This Court further observes that repeated directions have been issued from time to time and that compliance thereof has been periodically reported.

Today, it has been brought to the notice of this Court by the Mr. Vimal Chand Choudhary, learned *Amicus Curiae* and also Mr. Bhandari that the present conditions obtaining in respect of all five aforementioned issues have considerably materially deteriorated, and that for a substantial period of time, no update whatsoever has been placed before this Court by the Respondents with regard to the steps taken to address and maintain the said issues.

Mr. Gill, learned Additional Advocate General, appearing on behalf of the State, has sought some time to file a comprehensive updated report in respect of all the issues aforementioned. In view thereof, it is directed that all orders passed in these writ petitions touching upon the issues in question shall be consolidated and reported upon by the State, indicating in clear and specific terms the action taken pursuant thereto and the progress made as on date.
