In D.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 446/2015:-

Learned counsel appearing for the Nagar Nigam shall file a reply to the application (I.A. No.2/2025) before the next date and place before us the current status of the land.

Learned counsel for the respondent shall also file reply to the application (I.A. No.1/2026) filed by Mr. Vimal Choudhary, amicus curie relating to the shifting of the boarding station of Rajasthan State Road Transport Corporation (RSRTC) from Narayan Singh Tiraha to Transport Nagar Bajri Mandi.

Learned counsel for the RSRTC shall also be served with a copy of the application and he will also file a reply and response to the application.

The application (I.A. No. 1/2023) has been filed under Order 41 Rule 27 CPC for taking additional documents on record.

For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed, subject to just objection.

The application (I.A. No. 5/2022) filed with respect to compliance of the order dated 01.11.2022 has become otiose now and is accordingly disposed of.

In D.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 1803/2025:-

Learned Advocate General submits that an affidavit has been filed.

We have perused the affidavit and are not satisfied with the method and manner in which actions are being taken at the level of the State Authorities. We expect that after issuance of the charge sheet under Rule 16 of the Rajasthan Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1958, enquiries should reach a logical end and not be dropped in between. The concerned Authorities shall place before us the entire details as to at what

stage the enquiry proceedings are pending and also what action is being taken in cases where the enquiry has been dropped. The documents shall be produced before us as to the reason for dropping the enquiry.

List these cases again on 24.03.2026.

Meanwhile, affidavit may be filed.
