1. This contempt petition has been filed by the petitioner alleging non-compliance of order dated 25.05.2023.
2. By the order dated 25.05.2023, the Court allowed the petitioner as also Shri Bhanwar Lal S/o Shri Sitaram to submit their representation/objection alongwith necessary documents before the Municipal Board, Jobner within a period of a week raising all their claim qua the subject proper and further directed the Municipal Board, Jobner to pass a speaking and reasoned order on the representation/objection as was submitted within a period of four weeks thereafter in accordance with law.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the respondents submits that the representation/objections of the petitioner and the other party has been decided vide order dated 30.07.2024 after making due consideration on the averments made in the representation/objections and so also the other documents submitted and the order dated 30.07.2024 has been placed on record as Annuxure-R-1.

4. In view of the fact that the representation/objections of the petitioner and other party have already been decided by a reasoned and speaking order, in opinion of this Court, the respondents have complied with the order of the Court.

5. Accordingly this contempt petition is disposed of.

6. Contempt notice/s are discharged.
