Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no proceedings whatsoever has been carried out against the petitioner in pursuance to Section 38 of the Rajasthan Panchayati Raj Act, 1994 read with Rule 22 of the Rajasthan Panchayati Raj Rules, 1996 and thus, in absence of the same, the impugned order dated 29.01.2026 directing recovery of an amount of Rs.41,25,000/- from the petitioner could not have been passed.

Learned counsel further submits that earlier also, the petitioner had approached the Hon'ble Court against the recovery order dated 10.04.2019 by filing S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.8112/2019, wherein this Court vide its interim order dated 09.05.2019 was pleased to stay the effect and operation of the order dated 10.04.2019.

Taking note of the above, issue notices of the writ petition as well as stay application to the respondents, returnable by

19.02.2026. Notices may also be sent through registered post in addition to normal process.

Notices also be given *dasti* to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Additionally, learned counsel for the petitioner would be at liberty to serve a copy of the petition in the Office of Mr. Kapil Prakash Mathur, learned Additional Advocate General, who appears for respondents No.1 to 5.

It is clarified that subject to the notices being served upon respondents No.1 to 5, the stay application will be considered on the next date, as according to the petitioner, the respondents despite having absolute knowledge that the said amount of Rs.41,25,000/-, has been transferred in the account of Mr. Karan Singh Gurjar, no efforts whatsoever has been carried out by respondents No.1 to 5 for recovering the same from him.

List the matter on 19.02.2026 in the same category after showing the name of Mr. Kapil Prakash Mathur, learned Additional Advocate General, in the cause list.

In the meanwhile, learned counsel for the petitioner also seeks liberty to file an appropriate application for impleading Mr. Karan Singh Gurjar, as a respondent.
