Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the challenge made in the present writ petition to the impugned orders dated 09.12.2025, 25.07.2025 and 29.01.2024, has been made on several grounds including the primary ground that the appeal before the learned Sub-Divisional Officer (**SDO**), Srimadhapur, was filed by the respondents after a lapse of about 33 years and despite the said fact, while passing the order dated 29.01.2024,

the learned SDO has not given any finding whatsoever for condoning the said delay in accordance with law.

Taking note of the above, till further orders, the effect and operation of the impugned orders shall remain stayed and the parties are directed to maintain status quo *qua* the property in question and further, no proceedings are to be carried out by the respondents in furtherance to the impugned orders.
