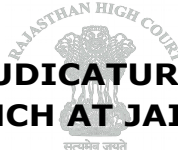

1. This second criminal miscellaneous bail application has been filed by the petitioner under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023 in respect of FIR No.08/2025 registered at Police Station Cyber Police Thana, District Bhiwadi for the offences punishable under Sections 317(2), 317(4), 318(2), 318(4), 112(2) and 61(2) of BNS and Section 66-D of I.T. Act.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the First Bail Application No.15513/2025 filed by the petitioner was withdrawn with liberty to file fresh after filing of the charge-sheet.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the investigation has been concluded and charge-sheet has been filed. Learned counsel further submits that co-accused namely; Anil Kumar, Rashid and Ankit Sharma have already been enlarged on



bail by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 08.04.2026 passed in S.B. Criminal Miscellaneous Bail Application Nos.3078/2026, 2360/2026 and 4962/2026 respectively. Learned counsel also submits that under these circumstances, the petitioner is no longer required for any custodial interrogation and trial is likely to take considerably long time. Hence, a prayer has been made to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed this second bail application.

5. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Public Prosecutor and in the light of the fact that after conclusion of investigation, challan has been filed and other co-accused have already been enlarged on bail by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 08.04.2026 passed in S.B. Criminal Miscellaneous Bail Application Nos.3078/2026, 2360/2026 and 4962/2026 respectively and petitioner is behind the bars since 21.09.2025, this Court without expressing any opinion on the merits and demerits of the case, deems it just and proper to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

6. Accordingly, this second Bail Application is hereby allowed. The accused-petitioner **Ajmat Ali S/o Deenu** shall be released on bail in pursuance of FIR No. 08/2025 registered at Police Station Cyber Police Thana, District Bhiwadi on furnishing a personal bond of Rs. 1,00,000/- along with two sureties of Rs.50,000/- each. That apart, the accused-petitioner shall also follow the conditions as under:-



(i) He shall not tamper with any evidence, nor would influence the witnesses in the case.

(ii) He shall not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

(iii) He shall co-operate in the trial and shall attend each and every date of hearing in the trial, until and unless his presence is exempted by the trial Court.

(iv) He shall regularly mark his attendance in the concerned Police Station on 25th day of every month. Concerned S.H.O. shall maintain the register of attendance of the accused-petitioner.

(v) On repetition of similar nature of offence during trial, the instant bail shall stand automatically cancelled.
