1. The present restoration application has been filed aggrieved of order dated 30.09.2024 passed by the Registrar (Judicial) whereby S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.9488/2015 was dismissed in pursuance to the *per-emptory* order dated 02.09.2024 passed by the Court.
