- 1. This bail application has been filed by the accused-petitioners under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, who have been arrested in connection with FIR No.191/2025 registered at Police Station Jaipur Airport, District Jaipur City (East) for the offence under Section 303(2) of BNS.
- 2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the accused-petitioners are innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this case. He also further submits that no recovery has been made from the petitioners. He also submits the accused-petitioners have been in judicial custody since 18.01.2026 and the conclusion of the trial will take long time, hence the petitioners may be enlarged on bail.

3. Learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State has vehemently opposed the bail application.

4. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.

5. Taking into consideration the overall facts and circumstances of the case, but without expressing any opinion on the merits and demerits of the case, this Court deems it just and proper to enlarge the petitioners on bail.

6. Accordingly, this bail application is allowed and it is ordered that the accused-petitioners **(1) Suraj Mehto S/o Mantu Mehto (2) Sekh Sobrati S/o Sekh Sabeet** be released on bail provided they furnish a personal bond in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) each with two sureties of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) each to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court for their appearance before the Court concerned on all subsequent dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.

7. Considering the criminal antecedent(s) of the accused-petitioners, it is directed that if they are found to be involved in offence of similar nature, then the prosecution shall be at liberty to file an application for cancellation of the bail granted to the accused-petitioners by this Court. The accused-petitioners are also directed to mark their presence on first week of every month till conclusion of trial before the concerned Police Station.
