1. The present petitions have been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 168/2012, registered at Police Station Jaipur Development Authority, Jaipur for the offences punishable under Sections 420 & 120-B of IPC.
2. Vide order dated 09.11.2012 passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, further proceedings in respect of FIR No.168/2012 have been stayed qua the petitioners.
3. The matters are pending for last almost 13 years.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner-Gopal Lal Sharma submits that the petitioner-Gopal Lal Sharma is the attesting witness of

the sale deed, moreover, his name is not there in the impugned FIR, therefore, he has not committed any offence.

5. In that view of the matter, the petitioners are directed to join the investigation and the Investigating Officer after due investigation shall submit its report on or before the next date of hearing.

6. However, it is made clear that the petitioners shall not be arrested in connection with FIR No.168/2012, registered at Police Station Jaipur Development Authority, Jaipur, till the next date of hearing.

7. List the matters after four weeks.
