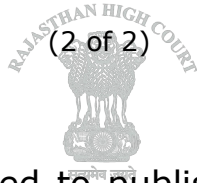

The matter comes up on an application under Order 5 Rule 20(IA) CPC read with Rules 7 & 9 of the Company Court Rules, 1959 seeking permission for paper publication of notice/substituted service upon the unserved respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the applicant submits that inspite of issuing several notice upon respondent No.4, he is avoiding service that is why he could not be served inspite of passing of considerable time. Learned counsel submits that permission be granted for publication of his notice in Hindustan Times (English and Hindi Edition) and Dainik Navjyoti (Rajasthan Edition).

For the reasons stated therein, the application stands allowed.



The applicant is allowed to publish the notice to respondent No.4 in the aforesaid newspapers. Office is directed to provide copy of notice to the applicant for the aforesaid purpose.

It is made clear that the expenses incurred towards publication of notices shall be deducted from the consolidated funds of the company in liquidation, available with the Official Liquidator.
