Counsel for the petitioner has moved an application for separation of trial with regard to respondent no.4 on the ground that they have not been able to serve notice on respondent no.4.

Counsel appearing for the respondents has pointed out that the applicant has not taken any steps for substituting service and submits that merely on the ground that registered notices have been returned. The trial of respondent no. 4 ought not to be separated.

After considering the submission of learned counsel for the petitioner and objection raised by learned counsel for the

respondent, this court deems it appropriate to direct the petitioner to take steps for substituting service within two weeks.

Application for separating trial is according rejected.
