1. The present criminal writ petition has been filed by the petitioner with the following prayers:-

"It is, therefore, humbly prayed that Your Lordship may be pleased to accept this writ petition and may be pleased to issue writ, order or direction in the nature thereof:

(i) To direct the non-petitioners to transfer immediately to the petitioner Prashandeep @ Parra

S/o Shri Suresh Chand from Central Jail Ajmer to Central Jail Alwar.

(ii) Alternative respondents may be directed to immediately consider the case of the petitioner for transferring to the Open Air Camp within a period of One Month.

(iii) To call for the record from the non-petitioner pertaining to the present matter;

(iv) To pass any other order which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the present case in favour of the petitioner."

2. Mr. Vishram Prajapati, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that an application dated 08.01.2026 (Annexure-1) has already been filed by the petitioner before respondent No.2 – Director General Of Prisons, Directorate Prison, Ghatgate, Jaipur (Raj.), for transferring the petitioner from the Central Jail, Ajmer to the Central Jail, Alwar, however, for reasons best known to respondent No.2, no decision has been taken on the same till date.

Thus, it is prayed that the concerned authority be directed to decide the same expeditiously in accordance with law.

3. Taking note of the aforesaid prayer and without delving into the merits/demerits of the case, respondent No.2 – Director General Of Prisons, Directorate Prison, Ghatgate, Jaipur (Raj.), is directed to consider and decide the application dated 08.01.2026 (Annexure-1) filed by the petitioner, within a period of one month

from the date of submission of the certified copy of this order, strictly in accordance with law.

4. Accordingly, with the aforesaid directions, the present criminal writ petition is disposed of.

5. Pending application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
