1. These restoration applications are identical, hence they are tagged together.
2. These restoration applications are filed to restore Writ Petition Nos. 17948/2022 and 18214/2022, which were dismissed pursuant to orders dated 26.05.2023 and 10.07.2023 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, as the petitioners failed to take steps to cure the defects as pointed out by the office.
3. Considered the submissions of learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners and Mr. Ashok Bansal appearing on behalf of the respondent-non-applicant.
4. The office is directed to reflect the name of Mr. Ashok Bansal as counsel for the respondent-non-applicant.
