Pursuant to order of this Court dated 20.02.2026, Ms. "I" is
produced before us by Ms. Sumit Kanwar-the Assistant Sub-
Inspector.

Although, her majority is disputed by learned counsel for the
respondents No.4 and 5-her parents but, from the documents

appended with the petition, it is found that she is major being 18 years of age.

On interaction, she submits that although, she was residing with her parents but, she was not in illegal detention. She further stated that she had married with the petitioner on 03.01.2026 and wants to go with him.

Since, she is found to be major from the documents appended with the memo of habeas corpus petition, she is at liberty to go wherever she wants.

Accordingly, this habeas corpus petition is disposed of with a direction to the police authorities to let her go wherever she wants.
