1. These second bail applications have been filed by the accused-petitioners under Section 483 of the B.N.S.S. in connection with FIR No.399/2025 registered at Police Station Sikri, District Deeg for offences under Sections 319(2), 318(4), 338, 336(3), 340(2), 317(2), 317(4), 317(5), 303(2), 313 and 61(2) of

B.N.S., 2023 and Section 66D of Information Technology Act, 2008.

2. The learned counsels for the accused-petitioners submit that the accused-petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case and they are in custody since 11.11.2025. Learned counsels further submit that Police after completion of investigation, has submitted charge-sheet in the matter and the accused-petitioners are no more required for any kind of interrogation or recovery. The learned counsels further submit that no other criminal case is pending against the petitioners, therefore, they may be released on bail.

3. Learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State opposed these second bail applications.

4. Considered the submissions made by the learned counsels for the accused-petitioners as well as learned Public Prosecutor.

5. Having regard to the submissions made by learned counsels for the accused-petitioners so also the fact that Police after completion of investigation has submitted charge-sheet in the matter and also the fact that no other criminal case is pending against the accused-petitioners, this Court without expressing any opinion on merits and demerits of the case, deems just and proper to enlarge the accused-petitioners on bail.

6. Accordingly, these second bail applications are allowed and it is directed that accused-petitioners shall be released on bail provided each of them shall furnish a personal bond in the sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lac Only), together with two sureties in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only) each to

the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the stipulation that they shall appear before that Court or any other Court to which the matter is transferred, on all subsequent dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
