1. Petitioner has challenged order dated 15.01.2026 passed by the Director Local Bodies, Rajasthan, Jaipur, whereby after carrying out disciplinary inquiry under the provisions of Rajasthan Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) (CCA) Rules, 1958 (hereinafter to be referred as 'the Rules of 1958') penalty of removal from service has been imposed upon the petitioner.

2. Penalty order dated 15.01.2026 is appealable under Rule 23 of the Rules of 1958. However, without availing the

alternative remedy, the petitioner has directly approached this Court by way of filing this writ petition, however, no reason whatsoever has been assigned for avoiding the alternative remedy and for directly approaching this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

3. In view of the availability of alternative and efficacious remedy appeal under the statutory Rules, this writ petition is hereby dismissed. However, mere dismissal of this writ petition would not preclude the petitioner from approaching the Appellate Authority under the Rules of 1958.
