Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondents have issued the impugned order dated 07.11.2025 debarring the petitioner-firm from participating in procurement process for a period of 5 years without issuing any notice or allowing reasonable opportunity of being heard as required under Section 46(5) of the Rajasthan Transparency Public Procurement Act, 2012 (hereinafter to be referred as "the Act of 2012"). He also submits that as per the provisions of the Act of 2012, a firm can be debarred for a maximum period of 3 years as has been provided under Section 46(4) of the Act of 2012, whereas, in the present case the petitioner-firm has been debarred for a period of 5 years. He also submits that the impugned order is a gross violation of principles of natural justice and is contrary to the statutory provisions.

Issue notice of the writ petition as well as of the stay application to the respondents, returnable within four weeks.
