1. This bail application has been filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner under Section 483 of B.N.S.S. in connection with FIR No. 76/2025 registered at Police Station Danta Ramgarh, District Sikar for the offence(s) punishable under Section(s) 19, 54, 54(A) of Rajasthan Excise Act, 1950.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and he has nothing to do with the alleged offences. Learned counsel further submits that co-accused namely, Daleep Singh has already been enlarged on bail by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, vide order dated 30.01.2026, in S.B. Criminal Misc. Bail Application No. 1724/2026. He also submits that the petitioner is in custody since 04.01.2026 and no recovery is required to be made from him. He further submits that the alleged offence(s) are triable by a Court of

Magistrate and investigation / trial of the case will take considerably long time in its conclusion, so no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody and therefore, prays that the petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

3. *Per contra*, learned Public Prosecutor vehemently opposes the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner hereinabove.

4. Having regard to the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case; considering the arguments advanced by learned counsel for the petitioner, the fact that co-accused has already been enlarged on bail by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, offence is triable by Magistrate and investigation / trial will take considerably long time in its conclusion, without commenting anything on merits / demerits of the case, this Court deems it just and proper to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

5. Therefore, this bail application under Section 483 B.N.S.S. is **allowed** and the accused-petitioner **Sandeep Singh S/o Shri Pratap Singh** is ordered to be released on bail, provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 50,000/- each to the satisfaction of the Trial Court, with the stipulation that he shall appear before that Court and any Court to which the matter is transferred, on all subsequent dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
