From the affidavit filed by respondent Nos.2 and 5, it transpires that a proposal for amendment in the rules is pending in the Office of the Governor since February, 2023 and the university is awaiting amendment in the rules so that it may proceed with the recruitment process.

It is further submitted that for the time being some working arrangement has been made.

Learned State Counsel appearing for the respondent No.1 is directed to pursue the matter relating to amendment pending in the Office of Governor so as to ensure that the amendment in the rule is expedited, as without that regular recruitment on the post

of Nursing Tutors cannot be made which in turn is adversely affecting teaching of nursing colleges which have been created to cater to the need of manning nursing staff in the hospitals.

On the next date of hearing, learned State Counsel may seek instructions and inform the Court whether the State is in position to spare 25 Nursing Tutors till regular recruitments are made in RUHS.
