1. The second bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is filed by the applicant-accused **Narendra Singh S/o Kajod Singh** seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No.47/2025 dated 24.01.2025 registered at P.S. Kishangargbas District – Khairthal Tijara, for the offence under Sections 115(2) and 126(2) of BNS.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against him is complete and he is no more required in investigation. He further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicant accused from the jurisdiction of this Hon’ble Court. He also submits that the applicant undertakes not to repeat offence and cooperate with investigation/trial, which will take time.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the first bail application was dismissed on 09.09.2025 with liberty to file after recording the statement of the injured. He submitted that now the injured has been examined as PW-4 and, in cross-examination, he had admitted that on the date of the incident he consumed "ganja". He also submitted that the material on record clearly reflects that the injured fell on rocks, which resulted in injury. At last, he submitted that the petitioner is in custody since his arrest.
4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application and submitted that the allegations are grave and serious in nature.
5. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner-accused and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.
6. On the basis of the report dated 24.01.2025 lodged by PW-1 Kallo (father of injured) about assault by Narendra Kumar in the night of 21.01.2025, FIR No. 47/2025 was registered on 24.01.2025 at Police Station Kishangarh Bas, District Khairthal Tijara. After investigation, the present petitioner was arrested and the charge sheet has been filed against him. The present petitioner is in custody since 24.02.2025. Till date, four witnesses were examined by the prosecution, which includes PW-1 Kallo (informant) and PW-4 (injured).
7. We have considered the cross-examination of PW-1 and PW-4, but we are not expressing any opinion about the portion of cross-examination as referred to by the learned counsel for the petitioner. PW-2 and PW-3 have turned hostile and

have not supported the case of the prosecution. We have also considered the injury report and X-ray report placed on record.

8. Upon hearing the arguments and perusing the record, we have found that the applicant-accused is no more required in the investigation and he is in custody for quite some time. The further proceedings will take its own time, therefore, looking to entirety of facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicant-accused.
9. Thus, the second bail application filed on behalf of applicant-accused **Narendra Singh S/o Kajod Singh**, is hereby allowed and the applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-
 - (i) The applicant-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.
 - (ii) The applicant-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
 - (iii) The applicant-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.
 - (iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicant-accused shall be liable to be canceled.
