Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is pursuing integrated B.Ed. course, however, in the meanwhile, he has been appointed on the post of Police Constable in GRP Ajmer, vide order dated 05.01.2026 and pursuant to such appointment order, the petitioner joined on 15.01.2026 and thereafter, applied for granting extra ordinary leave; however, the same has not been granted to the petitioner, which is causing hurdles in completion of his integrated B.Ed. course, which is being pursued by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has relied upon the judgment dated 09.01.2025 passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in **S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.61/2025 (Dr. Prateek Verma Vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors.)**.

Matter requires consideration.

Issue notices to the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to serve two copies of this writ petition in the office of Mr. Bhunesh Sharma, AAG, who shall seek instructions and file reply to the writ petition.

Name of Mr. Bhunesh Sharma, AAG be reflected in the cause list.

In the meanwhile, the respondents are restrained from taking any coercive action against the petitioner.
