1. This second bail application has been filed under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023 on behalf of accused-petitioner in connection with FIR No.555/2025 registered at Police Station Jhotwara, District Jaipur (West) for the offences under Sections 115(2), 126(2), 189(2) & 303(2) of BNS, 2023.
2. Heard.
3. Considered the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Public Prosecutor assisted by counsel for the complainant.
4. As per the injury report of the injured opined by the Medical Jurist, none of the injury sustained by the complainant party has



been opined to be dangerous to life. As per the contents of the FIR, the accused-petitioner has not been named and even in the statements of the injured-witness, no specific overt act has been assigned to him. The accused-petitioner is said to be in custody since 14.12.2025 and the Police after completion of investigation has already submitted charge-sheet in the matter.

5. Taking into consideration the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court without expressing any opinion on the merits or demerits of the case, deems just and proper to enlarge the accused-petitioner on bail.

6. Accordingly, the second bail application under Section 483 BNSS is allowed and it is ordered that the accused-petitioner named above shall be enlarged on bail provided, he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- together with two sureties of Rs.50,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge for his appearance before the Court concerned on all the dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
