Notice be given '*dasti*' to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Mr. V.D. Gathala, learned AGC, puts in appearance on behalf of the respondents No.2 and 5.

Hence, service is complete *qua* the aforementioned respondents.

Mr. V.D. Gathala, learned AGC, prays for and is granted four weeks' time to file reply to the writ petition and complete his instructions.

Additionally, learned counsel for the petitioner shall be at liberty to serve a copy of the writ petition in the Offices of Mr. Archit Bohra, Advocate, who appears on behalf of respondent No.1

and Mr. Kapil Prakash Mathur, learned Additional Advocate General, who appears on behalf of the respondents No.3 and 4.

Names of Mr. Archit Bohra, Advocate and Mr. Kapil Prakash Mathur, learned AAG, be shown in the cause list as learned counsel for their respective respondents.

Mr. Kartikeya Sharma, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite the petitioner having exclusive right and title over Khasra No.102 of village Chak, Chandpur Patwar area Nayavas, Tehsil Rahuvas, District Dausa, which is reflected from a bare perusal of the Jamabandi/Revenue records (Annexure-1), the respondents are raising construction over the said land of the petitioner in an illegal manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that repeated representations have been made by the petitioner to the respondents, however, no heed has been paid to the same and on the contrary, they are proceeding ahead with the construction over the land of the petitioner.

Taking note of the above, the respondents are restrained from carrying out any construction activity or demolition or dispossession of the petitioner from his land bearing Khasra No.102 situated at village Chak, Chandpur Patwar area Nayavas, Tehsil Rahuvas, District Dausa, till the next date.
