The present petition has been filed by the petitioner, aged about 30 years. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been duped by respondent No.2, who without having any appropriate recognition, affiliation, and permission to run the N.C.T.E course, under misrepresentation, had imparted education to the petitioner and similarly situated persons and that on account of same, the petitioner is facing difficulties to secure a placement.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that a notice for demand of justice in regard of the aforesaid has already been filed and that the same is pending since 27.10.2025 before

the Additional Chief Secretary, Higher Education, Government of Rajasthan, Cabinet Secretariat, Jaipur.

Heard the submissions advanced by the learned counsel.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the matter at hand, the Additional Chief Secretary, Higher Education, Government of Rajasthan is directed to afford an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner on 04.05.2026 at 11:00 am and it is directed that the grievances of the petitioner shall be adjudicated in light of the ratio spelled out in **Pawan Meena v. State of Rajasthan & Ors. (SBCWP No. 1665/2024)** and in accordance with the Circular dated 19.02.2024 (No. प. 10(1) प्रसु./अनु.-1/2012) issued by the Chief Secretary for the State of Rajasthan.

It is further directed that a well-reasoned and speaking order shall be passed within a period of 30 days from the date of passing of this order, strictly in accordance with law.

In above terms, the present petition is disposed of.

Pending applications, if any, stand disposed.
