1. This contempt petition has been filed by the petitioner alleging non-compliance of the order dated 05.03.2025 passed in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 2819/2000.
2. By the order dated 05.03.2025, the respondents were directed to allot an alternative piece of land of same price to the petitioner to the extent of his share in the subject land, as stated by the State in Para 1 of the preliminary objection in its reply to the writ petition, within a period of 16 weeks from the date of receipt of the application.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 05.03.2025, the petitioner submitted an application to the District Collector Sawai Madhopur on 11.03.2025. He further submits that even after specific directions of the Court and making application by the petitioner, no allotment has been made by the respondents even after passing of more than one and half years.

4. Learned counsel appearing for both the respondents fairly admits that no allotment has been made as directed by this Court vide order dated 05.03.2025.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents requests for some time for making compliance of the said order.

5. The Court vide order dated 05.03.2025 directed the State-respondent to make allotment of the land within a period of 16 weeks from the date of receipt of the application. The application was submitted by the petitioner on 11.03.2025 in compliance of the order of the Court and the period of 16 weeks as ordered by the Court ended on 11.07.2025, meaning thereby, the respondents were under obligation to make allotment of the land to the petitioner by 11.07.2025, but even after passing of more than one year, the respondents have not made any allotment.

7. The aforesaid facts are sufficient for holding the respondents *prima facie* guilty for non-compliance of the orders of the Court.

8. List this matter on 25.08.2026.

9. On the next date of hearing respondent No. 2 and so also the present District Collector, Sawai Madhopur shall remain personally present before this Court.

10. Learned counsel appearing for the respondents is also directed to instruct both the respondents to remain personally present before this Court on the next date of hearing i.e. on 25.08.2026.
