1. The present contempt petition has been filed alleging non-compliance of the order dated 05.03.2025 passed in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.2819/2000, which reads as under :-

"This writ petition is disposed of in following terms as agreed and requested by the learned counsels for the respective parties :-

- 1. The petitioner is at liberty to file an application for allotment of land in lieu of use of his land for air strip by the respondents, indisputably, without acquisition, within a period of four weeks from today.*
- 2. The respondents shall allot an alternative piece of land of same price to the petitioner to the extent of his share in the subject land, as stated by the State in Para 1 of the preliminary objection in its reply to the writ petition, within a period of sixteen weeks from the date of receipt of the application.*

Pending application(s), if any, also stands disposed of."

2. As the directions issued in the order dated 05.03.2025 were not complied by the respondents, the present contempt petition came to be filed, wherein vide order dated 21.08.2026, after considering the facts obtained, it was specifically recorded that as no allotment has been made to the petitioner as directed vide order dated 05.03.2025 and the period during which the compliance was required to be made has already gone by, the respondents *prima facie* are guilty for non-compliance of the orders of the Court. Thereafter, the matter was posted for 25.08.2026 and the respondent No.2 and so also the present District Collector, Sawai Madhopur, were directed to remain personally present before this Court.

3. However, on 25.08.2026, an application seeking exemption from personal presence on behalf of respondent No.2 was filed on the ground of forthcoming Elections of the Local Bodies, which was allowed vide order dated 25.08.2026 and appearance of both the officers were exempted for 25.08.2026, and the matter was directed to be listed today, i.e. 07.09.2026.

4. Today again, an application seeking exemption for personal appearance of District Collector, Sawai Madhopur, has been filed on the very same ground, which, after considering the obtained facts and circumstances, is allowed and accordingly, the District Collector, Sawai Madhopur, is granted exemption from personal appearance today.

5. Mr. G.S. Gill, learned Additional Advocate General for the respondents submits that Special Appeal Writ against the order dated 05.03.2025 has also been preferred and thus, the matter be listed on 07.10.2026,

6. Considering the said request, list the matter on **07.10.2026**.
7. However, it is clarified that in the event, the compliance of the order dated 05.03.2025 is not done on or before the said date, the respondent No.2 - District Collector, Sawai Madhopur, would remain personally present before this Court on **07.10.2026** at **10.30 A.M.**
