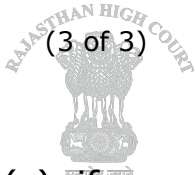

1. The instant writ petition has been filed by the petitioners, being aggrieved by the fact that the respondents have denied them salary for the summer vacation for the academic year in which they were initially appointed.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the issue in the present case is no more *res integra*. The Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in the case of **Yogesh Kumar Pareek Vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors. (S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.3534/2009)**, decided the similar controversy vide order dated 20.01.2024
3. Learned counsel further submits that a similar controversy was examined by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in the case of **Usha Soni Vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors.** in **S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.12258/2023** decided by order dated 18.07.2024.
4. In view of the above, counsel prayed that the present writ petition be allowed.
5. Mr. Devansh Sharma, Dy. G.C. appears on behalf of respondent-Department did not dispute the fact that the controversy has already been decided and **Yogesh Kumar Pareek (supra)** is applicable in the present case.
5. Accordingly, the present writ petition is allowed in the light of **Yogesh Kumar Pareek (supra)** and **Usha Soni (supra)**.
