1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner participated in the process of recruitment for the post of Class-IV employee. However, despite securing higher merit than the others, the appointment was not given to her. Learned counsel submits that time and again, the petitioner has contacted the respondent and submitted representation by highlighting her grievances, yet despite the fact that as many as 3 vacancies are still lying vacant, the petitioner has not been given appointment.

2. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, this writ petition is disposed of with direction to the respondent to decide the representation submitted by the petitioner.

3. In view of limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, this writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the

petitioner to make a fresh representation before Secretary, Lokayukat Secretariat, Government of Rajasthan, Jaipur within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. In case, any such representation is made, the Competent Authority is expected to decide the same within a period of 60 days from the date of receipt of representation.

5. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on merits of the case.

6. Pending application(s), if any, stand(s) disposed of.
