Considered submissions of learned counsel for parties.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that after judgment in
case of **Imran Khan Vs. State of Rajasthan and Ors. (SB
Civil Writ Petition No.17963/2019)** a Division Bench of
this Hon'ble Court at Principal Seat, Jodhpur in case of
**Garvit Vyas Vs. State of Rajasthan (D.B. Special
Appeal Writ No.111/2025 decided on 01.08.2025)** has
also considered identical issue and decided the same issue,
thus the order dated 13.01.2026 be modified to the extent

that the respondents be directed to consider judgment in case of **Garvit Vyas (supra)**, in addition to judgment in case of **Imran Khan (supra)**.

3. Learned counsel for respondent has no objection, hence application is liable to be allowed.
4. Having considered aforesaid, order dated 13.01.2026 in SB Civil Writ Petition No.4196/2021 is modified to the extent that respondents shall also consider ratio laid down in case of **Garvit Vyas (supra)** in addition to judgment in case of **Imran Khan (supra)**.
5. This order shall be treated as integral part of the order dated 13.01.2026.
6. Accordingly, the order dated 13.01.2026 in the writ petition stands modified.
7. Application stands disposed of.
