Order

1. It has been stated that petitioners have acquired membership, in the month of February, 2025 (on 11.02.2025), for

the Association of Union Bank Officers Rajasthan State. However, in order to deprive the petitioners from participating in the 9th General Body Meeting, scheduled on 26.02.2025, the present General Secretary of the Association has issued a notice dated 16.02.2025, putting a restriction that the members whose cheque- off status is valid as of January, 2025 shall be deemed to be eligible to participate in the General Body Meeting.

2. In addition, it has been argued that the previous 8th General Body Meeting was held on 23.07.2022 wherein the Officer Bearers of Association were elected for a term of three years and now before completion of three years (which would complete in the month of July, 2025), the General Body Meeting has been scheduled on 26.02.2025, vide notice dated 16.02.2025, that too without making compliance of the Rule 3.4.6 of the Federation Bye-laws since 15 days prior intimation to Federation to ensure meeting of the General Meeting has not been given.

3. Counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no alternative dispute resolution forum for the petitioners to raise and resolve the grievance of petitioners.

4. On behalf of respondents No.2 and 4, learned counsel has put in appearance on last dated on 21.02.2025 and today submits that the reply to the writ petition has been filed.

5. Initially, learned counsel for the respondents No.2 and 4 raised a preliminary objection that the requisite fee of Rs.200/- each has not been deposited by the petitioners, hence they have not yet become the member of Association. However, during course of argument, counsel for the respondents No.2 and 4

submits that Association has no objection, if petitioners appear and participate in the General Body Meeting scheduled on 26.02.2025. Learned counsel for the respondents No.2 and 4 further submits that consent to hold the General Body Meeting on 26.02.2025 has been given by the All India Union Bank Officers Federation.

5. This Court asked the counsel for respondent No.2 and 4 to show consent of Federation but no such written consent has been shown to the Court nor has been enclosed with the reply.

6. Let notice be issued to the respondents No.1- Union Bank and No.3-All India Union Bank Officers Federation.

7. In the meanwhile, in view of concession given by learned counsel for the respondents No.2 and 4, petitioners are permitted to appear and participate in the General Body Meeting scheduled on 26.02.2025, however it is made clear that the decision of the General Body Meeting on the agenda No.4, "to elect the office bearers for forthcoming term" shall remain subject to approval of the General Body Meeting by the All India Union Bank Officers Federation.

8. List the writ petition on 20.03.2025.
