1. All these matters are identical, hence, they are tagged together.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) while placing reliance upon judgment in case of **Gajanand Sharma Vs. Adarsh Siksha Parisad Samiti and Others : AIR 2023 SC 539** submits that without compliance of Section 18 of the Rajasthan Non-Governmental Educational Institutions Act, 1989, the services of

the petitioner were terminated by respondent No.1. He further submits that as on today, no Presiding Officer is posted in the Rajasthan Non-Governmental Educational Institutions Tribunal and the post is lying vacant, so the petitioner(s) have no remedy except to invoke extra-ordinary jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. He further submits that at least interim order to stay the termination order be passed in their favour.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent Nos. 1, 4 and 5 requests for time to file at least short reply to the stay application(s) or in form of preliminary objection as he has objection about territorial jurisdiction of this Court.

4. Issue notice to respondent Nos. 2 and 3.

5. Service upon standing counsel is also permitted. Mr. Manoj Sharma, AAG and Mr. M.S. Raghav be served notice for respondent Nos.2 and 3 respectively.

6. Office is directed to reflect name of Mr. Manoj Sharma, AAG and Mr. M.S. Raghav as counsel for the respondent Nos. 2 and 3 respectively.

7. Having considered the submissions and also the material on record, Office is directed to list these matters for consideration of the stay application(s) and also preliminary objection about the territorial jurisdiction on 06.03.2026.
