1. This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner for seeking directions to the Rajasthan Civil Services Appellate Tribunal, Jaipur for deciding the contempt petition No.230/2025 expeditiously.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner instituted the contempt petition on 23.09.2025, in which although, notices have been issued to the respondents, however, till this date, compliance of earlier order dated 08.07.2025 was not made by the respondents. Learned Tribunal has posted the matter on 21.04.2026, which is causing grave prejudice and miscarriage of justice to the petitioner.

3. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

4. In respect of contempt application filed by the petitioner on 23.09.2025, filing a writ petition for seeking direction for expeditious disposal, is misconceived petition, moreso when it has not been pleaded in the petition that the hearing of the contempt application has been unnecessarily delayed by the Tribunal. Under these circumstances, this Court does not find any merit in the writ petition filed by the petitioner and same is hereby dismissed.

5. However, dismissal of this writ petition shall not take away rights of the petitioner to submit an application for early listing before the Tribunal and in case, such application is filed, the Tribunal shall decide the same in accordance with law.
