Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner participated in the recruitment process for the Assistant Professor (Business Administration) with 'OBC' category and after undergoing the recruitment process, the petitioner got 38<sup>th</sup> merit position and on account of securing more marks than the cut-off marks of unreserved category, he has been shifted to the 'General' category.

Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that thereafter the petitioner is required to fill verification form containing a clause with regard to pending criminal cases. The petitioner filled the form disclosing the details with regard to pending/decided criminal matters against him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that there were two criminal cases against the petitioner and both the cases have been finally decided and the petitioner has been acquitted in both the criminal cases. He also submits that vide letter/order dated 27.01.2026 (Annexure-1), the candidature of the petitioner

has been rejected allegedly on the ground that the committee constituted for the purpose of examining the eligibility of the candidates, who were having criminal cases against them and even judgment of acquittal has been passed. But after examining the matter, the committee recommended for not granting appointment to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that post of Assistant Professor (Business Administration) is still lying vacant.

Matter requires consideration.

Issue notices to the respondents.

In the meanwhile and till further orders, one post of Assistant Professor (Business Administration) in unreserved category shall be kept vacant for the petitioner and shall not be filled without permission of this Court.
