It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that by submitting application pursuant to advertisement dated 12.12.2024 for the post of Class-IV employee, since the petitioner is suffering from locomotor disability, cerebral palsy and mental illness, therefore, she applied in the category of 'Specially Abled Person' and also uploaded her disability certificate certifying that the petitioner is also suffering from Cerebral Palsy with Mental Retardation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that on account of suffering such mental disability, the petitioner herself was not in a position to submit her online application form and it was submitted by some other person, who in bona fide ignorance, although shown category of the petitioner as Locomotor Disability/Cerebral Palsy & Other, yet in the relevant clause mentioned in the application form relating to mental disability, he clicked option 'No'.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that since the disability certificate has also been uploaded by the petitioner proving her mental disability, therefore, such bona fide error cannot come in the way of the petitioner to deprive her for consideration.

Matter requires consideration.

Issue notices to the respondents.

In the meanwhile, respondents shall not restrain the petitioner to participate in document verification. However, such provisional permission shall not create any equity in favour of the petitioner and shall remain stayed subject to decision of the writ petition.
