Mr. Rishi Raj Maheshwari, learned counsel for the petitioner,
at the very outset, has placed reliance on an order passed by the
Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in ***S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.***
7160/2024 titled as ***Ujjivan Small Finance Bank & Anr.***
Versus State of Rajasthan & Anr., decided on 09.05.2024,

wherein, in similar circumstances, the District Collector has been directed to decide the pending application of the petitioner under Section 14 of the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest (**SARFAESI**) Act, 2002, within a stipulated time.

The fact and applicability of the said order are not disputed by learned counsel for the respondents. Thus, taking guidance from the order passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in the ***Ujjivan Small Finance Bank (supra)***, the present writ petition is disposed with a direction to the respondent No.1 – District Collector, Deeg, to decide the pending application of the petitioner filed under Section 14 of the SARFAESI Act, dated 24.06.2025, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, strictly in accordance with law.

With the aforementioned direction, the present writ petition stands disposed of .

Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
