1. In the instant matter, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that an electric line and a transformer are currently situated adjacent to the boundary of the petitioner's residential house, and that the same is posing a grave and imminent hazard to human life.
2. It is submitted that pursuant to the demand raised by the respondent-authorities, the petitioner had duly deposited the requisite amount for the immediate shifting of the said transformer. However, despite the remittance of the required amount and the submission of repeated representations, the respondent-authorities have failed to shift the transformer.
3. It is next submitted that subsequent to the aforesaid administrative inaction, the petitioner's application seeking a fresh electricity connection has also been wrongfully rejected by the respondents. It is contended that the stated ground for the said rejection is the hazardous installation of the same transformer on

the boundary, which the authorities themselves have failed to rectify despite receiving the shifting charges.

4. Heard the preliminary submissions advanced by the learned counsel.
5. Issue notices to the respondents.
6. On directions of the Court, Mr. Sagar Jindal, accept notices on behalf of the respondents.
7. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply a copy of the present petition in the office of Mr. Sagar Jindal, during the course of the day.
8. List the matter on 14.05.2026 after showing the name of Mr. Sagar Jindal as counsel for the respondents in the cause list.
9. Reply be filed in the meantime.
